Mozambique's oil and gas sector is expected to experience substantial development in the next few years following the recent discoveries of important gas reserves in the Rovuma basin, near the border with Tanzania.

The onshore Panda and Temane gas fields have proven reserves of 3.5 trillion cubic feet and major operators such as Petronas, ENI, Statoil and Anadarko are

already engaged in exploration, both onshore and offshore.
